These can involve tasks such as learning a new skill, experiencing a cultural event or participating in an activity outside of the classroom. It also gives the students an opportunity to practice skills that we develop in the classroom, in areas such as:

- Grace and Courtesy
- Taking Responsibility
- Safety

These experiences are purposeful extensions of the classroom work and an important part of the elementary program. ‘Going out’ events can include small group excursions or whole class field trips. During these outings, the students will be supervised by an MISD staff member.

Information about the particular event will be communicated to you prior, including any essential items your child will need. We do require that your child wears their field trip shirt to any event that occurs off campus.

To help foster independence and a greater awareness of being out in public, we will endeavor to travel to and from the campus by foot or on public transport. If this is not possible, the students will be transported by car. All drivers/chaperones are required to submit a copy of the license and insurance prior to the event.
